Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

This Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) meets the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/425 of the European Parliament and of the Council on PPE.

The EU type examination carried out shows that the PPE complies with the harmonized standards EN 407: 2004 (DIN EN 407: 2004-11) - Protective gloves against thermal risks (heat and / or fire) - and

EN 420: 2003 + A1: 2009 (DIN EN 420: 2010-03) - Protective gloves - General requirements and test methods - equivalent.

Fabric: 100% Cotton
Filling: 100% Polyester

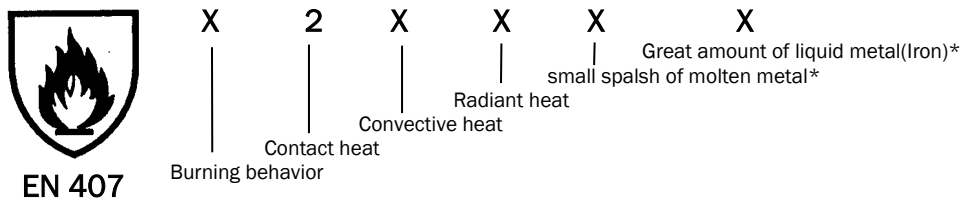
Wash separately.
Detergents without optical brighteners are to be used.
Do not use fabric softeners.

Size: 22 x 22 cm

Intended use:

The RÅ Potholders are supposed to protect your hand from the heat when handling hot dishes.

Labeling: Pictograms with performance levels, where a higher number means better protection:



The designation "X" instead of a number means that the glove has not been tested for the corresponding risk.

Class 1 means the lowest power level.



Potholder sizes:

The potholder sizes correspond to the application purpose. The potholders protect the palm of the hand as well as the fingers.

Risk assessment:**As a user of the potholders, please note the following advice for assessing the risks associated with the use:**

The PPE protects against the risks covered by this standard. The potholders protect only the hands against short-term contact (under 15s) with heat. The other parts of the body are excluded from the protection. The protection against thermal risks (heat) is determined by the observance of the Standard for the specific body parts (palm of the hand as well as the fingers) covered. Avoid direct contact with fire.

Maintenance:

Follow the care instructions.

Storage:

Store in a dry place.

Expiration date:

5 years after production date.

Control:

Visual inspection for contamination and damage is essential.
Damaged potholders must be discarded!
